Certain hardness's can be machined into shapes for wheels, rollers and washers.

Pu rods are also commonly used as strippers in tool, die and metal stamping industries.

We offer Pu rods in a variety of colours in thicknesses from 12mm - 125mm. Generally the rods are supplied 12" (300mm) long, but certain diameters are available 500mm & 1000mm long.

Although this data sheet covers our general range, we can also supply rods in hardness's up to 60° Sh D to special order, subject to minimum order quantities.
